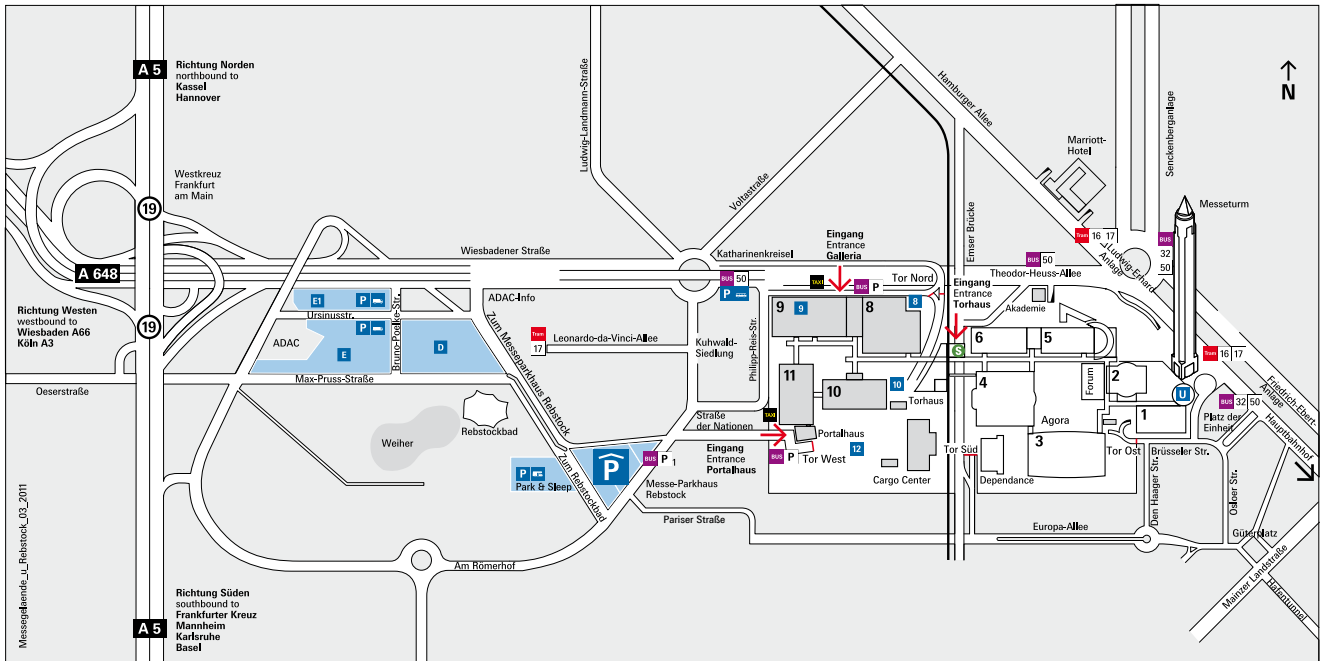

Frankfurt Low Emission Zone

A low emission zone (Umweltzone) is valid for the city of Frankfurt. From 1 January 2012, this zone can only be accessed by vehicles belonging to Pollutant Group 4 and bearing the relevant emissions stickers (www.umweltzone.frankfurt.de). Emissions stickers for vehicles from Germany and abroad indicating the relevant Pollutant Group can be ordered at www.tuev-sued.de/auto_fahrzeuge/feinstaub-plakette/feinstaubplakette_ausland.

Access to the exhibition grounds:

The low emission zone in Frankfurt is located within the motorway ring road comprising the motorways A5 in the west, A3 in the south and

A661 in the east. Vehicles belonging to one of the relevant Pollutant Groups and bearing the corresponding emissions stickers can access the exhibition grounds at any time. Vehicles without stickers can also reach the exhibition grounds: The exhibition grounds can be accessed by vehicles without emissions stickers via Gate West or Gate North. These can be reached via motorway A648 (coming from the A5) taking the "Rebstock" exit or via the Katharinenkreisel roundabout. Messe Frankfurt's Rebstock multi-storey car park can also be reached via the "Rebstock" exit. The low emission zone can only be accessed by vehicles with emissions stickers. Driving a vehicle into a low emission zone without

one of these stickers constitutes an offence and can lead to a fine. Emissions stickers can be purchased:

Set-up - You have a full 5 days

You can begin setting up your exhibition stand on 6 January 2012, a full five days before the fair begins. Normally this is enough time. However, if you would like to start your set-up work in advance of this,

Where are the set-up passes issued?

On all official set-up days, from 6 to 10 January 2012, the passes for all halls will be issued between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. at Gate "Tor

West".
Between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. the passes will be issued at Gate "Tor Nord" only.

We care about your safety

One aim of our organisation is to give all exhibitors the chance to load or unload their vehicles in the loading zone of their exhibition hall. Another of our aims is to do everything possible to ensure your

safety. For this, however, we need your support. All emergency routes and access points must be kept clear at all times. This also applies to hall entrances and the areas in front of the lifts. Please note that

the maximum speed at the Exhibition Centre is 30 km/h. Motor vehicles are not permitted inside the exhibition halls.

We admit no vehicles that are more important than yours

Only vehicles delivering stand-construction materials and/or exhibits will be permitted into the Exhibition Centre. To this end, you will be given a set-up pass with which you can enter the Exhibition Centre. To accelerate the issue of these passes

please prepare the following information:

- company's name
 - stand number
 - driver's mobile phone number
- These passes are only valid when filled out and must be placed in a

clearly visible position behind the windscreen of your vehicle, so the driver can be found immediately should it be necessary to move the vehicle. Complying with this rule ensures we do not have to tow away your vehicle at your expense.

Loading zones are for loading and unloading, not for parking

In order to ensure that all exhibitors have equal opportunity to unload their materials in the unloading zone for their exhibition hall, set-up passes specify the times by which the vehicles must have left the exhibition grounds.

All vehicles must depart the exhibition grounds as soon as they have been unloaded/loaded. The following loading times must not be exceeded:

Trucks over 3.5 t gross vehicle weight rating:

6 - 8 January 2012:

max. 12 hours

9 - 10 January 2012:

max. 6 hours

Vans up to 3.5 t gross vehicle weight rating and cars with trailers:

6 - 8 January 2012:

max. 6 hours

9 - 10 January 2012:

max. 3 hours

Naturally these times also apply to any associated trailers, semi-trailers and swap bodies.

Cars delivering stand construction materials and/or exhibits may also enter the exhibition grounds. You will be given set-up passes for this purpose that allow you to spend a maximum of two hours on the exhibition grounds to go to your exhibition hall and unload.

Stress-free set-up during the night

The exhibition halls are open 24 hours a day - round the clock - during the entire official set-up period. Take advantage of the

quieter night-time hours to set up your stand. Between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., you can leave your vehicle parked at the exhibition hall

as long as you wish. No night surcharges will be levied on orders for night-time forklifts or personnel.

We keep the loading areas clear of cars

If you do not have to drive into the loading zones or only have small loads to deliver we hold car parking spaces at your disposal.

For this purpose, you will be given a free car-parking permit during the set-up days: from 6 to 10 January 2012 at Gate "Tor Nord"

(for exhibitors in halls 3 - 6) and at Gate "Tor 9" (for exhibitors in halls 8 - 11).

Parking your containers, swap bodies and trailers requires our authorisation

The parking of containers, swap bodies, trailers or other storage units on the exhibition grounds must be coordinated with one of our official freight forwarders or directly with us.

Please understand that we can only authorise the parking of storage units during an event if they

are directly necessary for supplying the stand, e.g. as brochure storage or as a cooling unit for perishable goods. All unauthorised storage units will be removed at the exhibitor's expense.

Rent loading & unloading devices from us

Cranes, forklifts and other devices for loading/unloading may only be used by Messe Frankfurt's Logistics Service. The employment of exhibitors' own forklifts is prohibited for safety reasons. If required, forklifts for loading/unloading are available on a fee basis from the

Messe Frankfurt Logistics Service. The utilisation of electric lift trucks for transporting goods at ground level is permitted. Electric lift trucks may only be used for assembly work on the rented stand area; their use for loading or unloading is prohibited.

End of set-up ...

... is at 3 p.m. on the eve of the fair. From this time on, all aisles and special areas must be kept clear so that the halls and the grounds can be cleaned and the

aisle carpeting can start. Please continuously remove stand-construction materials, exhibits and empties from the aisles so that these works can start punctually.

During the fair - We reserve car parking spaces for you during the event

We provide parking spaces (at extra cost) for cars up to 2.5 tonnes max. permitted weight for the duration of the event. Reserve your parking space(s) in good time before the event, using the Easyorder

online system. For car trailers, there is a parking area at the Exhibition Centre. A charge will be made for this facility, which you can also book using Easyorder. Parking facilities for vans and trucks

are available for a fee at the truck parking area of Messe Frankfurt Venue GmbH & Co. KG, Rebstock parking E and E1.

We also allow your delivery vehicles into the Exhibition Centre during the fair

It is possible to drive into the exhibition grounds for one hour to deliver goods during the fair (only until 2 p.m. on the last day). On

entry into the exhibition grounds, each driver must pay a deposit of EUR 100, which will be forfeited if the deadline is exceeded. Entry

Dismantling

Vehicles will not be allowed to enter the Exhibition Centre after 2 p.m. on Saturday, 14 January 2012.

Admission for your dismantling vehicles

Please drive your vehicles straight to the designated dismantling area at the Rebstock car park. This is the only place you can receive your

dismantling vehicle pass to enter the exhibition grounds, and it is the only place where entry will begin at 8:00 p.m.

Access from other streets will not be granted until all of the vehicles from this area have already entered the exhibition grounds.

You just need to remove your coffee machine?

We offer you the opportunity to remove small items in advance of general admission for dismantling vehicles on Saturday, 14 January 2012, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. We will be issuing a limited number of "special dismantling passes" for cars and vans up to 3.5 tonnes gross vehicle weight during the last two days of the setup period and during the fair itself until all have been taken.

You can obtain these "special dismantling passes" at the Central Information Desk on Level 03 of the Torhaus – a 200 euro cash deposit is required.

These passes are available in limited quantities, so we recommend that you obtain yours as early as possible. They cannot be ordered in advance.

Entry starting at 5:00 p.m. and departure by no later than 7:00 p.m.

are only possible at the gate specified on the pass. Your 200 euro deposit will only be returned if you leave the exhibition grounds with your vehicle by 7:00 p.m. After this time, we keep the deposit, and your pass serves as your receipt. Please note that you will not be able to use the goods lifts due to the fact that the removal of the aisle carpeting from the exhibition halls takes place at the same time.
